Program open to anyone over 18, with no pre-requisite of diploma and/or French proficiency (except




recommended).

Mornings are dedicated to the practice of language with 45 hours of oral and written communication, reinforcement of grammatical structure, vocabulary enrichment and oral practice in an audio lab.

For the afternoons, students can choose:

- one of 6 thematic tracks which all include 30 hours of lectures and site visits
- a 30 hour «Leisure & visits» program.

Each session students can participate, free of charge, to one of the two one-day excursions scheduled on week-ends, provided that places are available.


